Number of credits: 5 credits per semester

Contact hours: 60 hours per semester *

Hours taught per week: between 12 and 16 hours during the integration period* and 4 hours during the regular teaching period

Teaching period: Fall 2018 and spring 2019

*Exception for SELF annual students in the spring semester: 20 hours of French and no orientation period

Course description:

Oral: Speaking and understanding

Writing: Writing and understanding

Grammar / Conjugation / Spelling / Vocabulary

Course level

Students will take a placement test upon arrival at Lyon 3 and will be split into the relevant level groups.

Course objectives

Thanks to appropriate teaching, the course aims to enable students to better express themselves and understand the main issues of a conversation when a clear and standard language is used. Students should be able to communicate with ease and integrate into the academic social and cultural world.

Assessment:

At least 6 marks, five for continuous assessment and one for a final written exam. Different ratios apply according to the mode of assessment

Attendance:

In order to participate, students must be present. Nevertheless, a maximum of 2 (two) unexcused absences will be allowed otherwise no mark will be given. An unexcused absence at the final test means no credits for the course.
