## **Company Law and Governance**

#### **Course information**

Number of credits : 6 credits

Contact hours : 30 hours

Hours taught per week : 2,5 hours or 3 hours

Teaching period : Spring semester 2025

#### **Course description :**

A practical approach to company law, governance and the role of the Board and the Company Secretary/ Governance professional. This course is designed to give an introductory overview of company law principles based on common law traditions. It will cover foundational topics including the formation of companies, the corporate personality doctrine, director duties, shareholder rights and corporate governance. The latter topic is instrumental in the running of companies, and we will look at the role of the Governance professional/ Company Secretary responsible for guiding, advising and assisting the Board on strategic, governance, compliance, statutory and legal matters and their central role in the operation and administration of a company or group of companies.

## Prerequisites :

None, but an interest in company law and governance is helpful.

## **Course objectives:**

- Obtain an understanding of company law in the UK and the types of company structure.
- Explain the history and purpose of the UK Corporate Governance Code.
- Identifying the role of the Board and key stakeholders.
- Understanding the importance and practical application of corporate governance.
- How behaviours, cultures policies and procedures interact with company law, regulations and codes of practice.
- Avoiding tick-box compliance exercises and understanding the importance of comply/apply and explain principles instilled via the Corporate Governance Code.
- An insight into the role of the Governance professional in practice.

#### Assessment:

50% final written exam (in class)

50% work in class (e.g. participation, group work, presentation, case study)

### Attendance:

In order to participate, students must be present. Nevertheless, a maximum of 2 (two) <u>unexcused</u> absences will be allowed; otherwise no mark will be given. An unexcused absence at a test (final test or continuous assessment) means no credits for the course.
